GEORGE CAMP TIPPINS 1824-cl875

George Camp Tippins was born in 1824 in Georgia. At the age of 12, he enrolled as a private on Oct. 4, 1836 at Garry's Ferry in Capt. Smith's Company of Mounted Rangers, 1st Regiment (Warren's), Florida Militia and served until Feb. 4, 1837. On August 24, 1840, George C. Tippins enrolled in Capt. Thigpin's Company of Florida Mounted Militia and was mustered out at Ft. Heileman, East Florida on Dec. 11, 1840.

George married Sarah Ann Yates about 1845. She was born in Appling County, Georgia in 1829, daughter of James Yates (born cl776 in SC) and his wife, Agnes "Aggy" Rowland (born 1805). Children of George Camp and Sarah Ann (Yates) Tippins:

1. Caroline Elizabeth Tippins, born Nov. 26, 1846; married cl862 Aaron M. "Gin" Jernigan, son of Isaac & Mary Jernigan; they were later divorced.
2. Mary Ann "Mollie" Tippins, born Aug. 29, 1848; married on Aug. 14, 1862, John Nelson "Goff" Patrick, son of John & Mary Elizabeth "Eliza" (Robinson/Robertson) Patrick.
3. George Washington Tippins, born Dec. 3, 1850; married on Aug. 22, 1867 Susan "Sarah" Jane Johnson, daughter of Elias E. & Elizabeth (Keen) Johnson.

In 1846, George C. Tippins & wife along with his father-in-law, James Yates' family & his married brother-in-law, Needham Yates, settled in the Black Creek District of Duval County, Florida.

George was mustered in Capt. Bullock's Independent Company of Florida Mounted Volunteers on Sept. 11, 1856 at Mellonville, Fla., as a corporal. He was mustered out on March 10, 1857. George also was a corporal in Capt. Bullock's Company from March 11, 1857 to Sept. 10, 1857. George was mustered into Capt. Bullock's Company for a third time on Sept. 28, 1857
