The following information is provided by Mr. R. K. Bell, 908 Andres Ave., Coral Gables, Fl. 33134. The tax roll was found by Mr. Bell among papers and files of pioneer lawyer, Arthur F. Odlin, who came to Arcadia from Orlando around the turn of the century and whose law offices were acquired by Mr. Bell's father.
