JAMES ARTHUR ALBRITTON 1846-1921

James Arthur Albritton was born in Columbia County, Florida
 on July 15, 1846, son of Thomas H. and Francis (Waldron) Albritton.
 The Albrittons left Columbia County in the mid-1850's, lived in
 Putnam County for several years and finally homesteaded near Lily
 in Manatee (present day Hardee) County in south Florida. The 1860
 census listed the Albrittons living in that area along with their
