JOHN MASTON BATES 1832-1918

John Maston Bates was born on March 25, 1832 in Camden County, Georgia son of James Maston Bates and grandson of Rev. Fleming & Margaret Bates. The Bates families settled in Alachua County, Fl. prior to 1840. The 1840 Alachua County census listed Wilson, Maston & Fleming Bates as residents that year. James settled in Hernando County prior to 1850.

John Maston Bates married Elizabeth Jackson on January 3, 1856 at Cedar Tree in Hernando County, Florida. She was born December 23, 1834 in Georgia. Their children:

1. James Maston Bates, born September 25, 1856; married Nancy E. Messer February 27, 1887.
2. Louisa Piety Bates, born October 7, 1858; married Henry Futch February 5, 1885.
3. Martha E. Bates, born February 23, 1860; died 1943; married Daniel H. Alderman March 25, 1880 (Daniel was the son of Jesse and Adeline (Prine) Alderman; married 2nd, _____ Green.
4. Margaret Ann Bates, born September 25, 1861; married Daniel S. Pate, July 31, 1888.
