Hard cover is \$16.69 (\$15 + 94¢ postage & 75¢ sales tax). It is primarily a family history of Walter D. and Blanche Williams Bell during his career as lawyer, jurist & legislator in Ft. Myers & Arcadia, Fl. from 1903-1930s but also contains partial family histories & accounts of other relatives including the Bell, Herndon, Pearce & Williams families of earlier years.
